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GDOT to Host Public Open House for Proposed Roundabout Improvements

[Columbus, Georgia] – The Georgia Department of Transportation and Transportation Investment Act Program will host a Public Information Open House for proposed improvements at the Schomburg Road and Blackmon Road bridges over J.R. Allen Parkway (P.I. No. 0019535).

The open house will be held Tuesday, October 13, 2026, from 5–7 p.m. at Blackmon Road Middle School, 7251 Blackmon Road. The public may attend at any time; no formal presentation will be given.

The project includes proposed single-lane roundabouts, sidewalks, raised medians and pedestrian-safety improvements.
