I. QUESTION(S)/RESPONSE(S)

Question 1: Section 8 - Question L – Want to confirm if this question is intended to confirm that we have the ability to use our actuarial tools to identify the most cost effective network discounts for these provider types.

Response: Yes. The intent of this question is to assess the proposer's ability to utilize actuarial and analytical tools to evaluate provider network arrangements and identify cost-effective network discounts and strategies for the referenced provider categories.

Question 2: Section 9 – Question B – Want to confirm if the list of terminated references need to be local governments or could be similar size organizations in other industries?

Response: The references do not need to be limited to local government entities. References from organizations of similar size and complexity in other industries are acceptable.

Question 3: Medical Insurance – Does the City currently cover GLP-1s for weight loss? If so, do you offer a specific program for member currently utilizing those prescriptions?

Response: The City currently covers GLP-1 medications in accordance with the provisions of its medical plan and applicable formulary requirements. Information regarding any specific programs available to members utilizing these prescriptions will be provided by the current carrier and is not part of the broker evaluation criteria.

Question 4: Dental Insurance – Can you confirm if your dental insurance is currently self-funded or fully insured?

Response: The City’s dental plan is currently self-funded.

Question 5: How is the current broker/consultant compensated?

Response: The current broker/consultant is compensated through a fixed annual consulting fee paid by the City.
