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CPD Officers Stabbed While Responding to Neighbor Dispute

On Saturday, September 26, 2026 at 3:21 a.m., Columbus Police Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd regarding a dispute between neighbors.

After officers resolved the initial dispute, Makayla Jacobson, 22, caused another disturbance while officers were still on scene. When two officers approached Jacobson to take her into custody, she retrieved a knife and stabbed both officers.

Both officers were transported to Piedmont Columbus Regional with non-life-threatening injuries. They have since been treated and released.

Jacobson was arrested and charged with the following:

- Aggravated Assault on a Peace Officer x2
- Felony Obstruction x2
- Possession of a Knife During the Commission of a Crime

The Violent Crimes Unit is leading the investigation. Jacobson is scheduled to appear in Recorder's Court for a preliminary hearing on Monday, September 28, 2026 at 8 a.m.
