

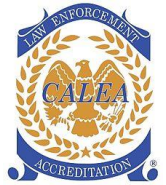

CPD's Special Operations Unit Makes Eight Arrests in Narcotics Investigations

Between July 14-16, 2026, the Columbus Police Department's Special Operations Unit concluded four separate narcotics investigations, resulting in the arrest of eight individuals and the seizure of illegal drugs, firearms, and other evidence.

During the investigations, detectives executed multiple search warrants and seized:

- 1,471 grams (3.24 pounds) of methamphetamine
- Seven firearms, including one sawed-off shotgun and two firearms with altered or obliterated serial numbers
- 3.9 grams of crack cocaine
- 74.6 grams of marijuana
- 32.1 grams of THC edibles (Schedule I)
- Three and a half Xanax pills
- Two Hydrocodone pills
- Two Adderall pills

The estimated street value of the seized narcotics is \$67,521.

The investigations resulted in 32 felony charges and six misdemeanor charges, including multiple trafficking and firearms offenses, as well as two felony probation violation warrants related to previous trafficking convictions.



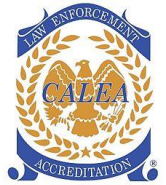

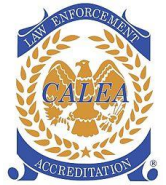
